## Why Austria's Renovation Rate Must Double – Insights from Wolfgang Amann

Austria's renovation rate remains critically low at just 1.5%, well short of the 2.8% needed under the new EPBD targets. With 1.85 million homes in need of refurbishment, Wolfgang Amann (IIBW) warns that fragmented data, insufficient incentives, and a lack of political urgency are stalling progress. Without a shift to large-scale renovation, Austria risks falling behind its climate commitments—systemic change is urgently required.

### Slovenian Joint National Roundtable | 12 June 2025



As part of the RENOINVEST and SMAFIN EXPANDED projects, more than 80 stakeholders from government, finance, industry, and research convened in Ljubljana to address how to accelerate sustainable investments. The discussions underlined the importance of simplified tenders, a single contact point for investors, more flexible financial instruments, and a stronger role for the state as an "anchor investor" to encourage private sector participation. #### Austria – Financial Working Group (FWG) Meeting | 7 July 2025

On 7 July 2025, a Financial Working Group meeting in Vienna gathered experts and policymakers under the EU LIFE RENOINVEST project to shape Austria's National Action Plan for building renovation. Key proposals included reviving the Housing Investment Bank (WBIB), creating regional one-stop-shops and renovation coaches, and simplifying permitting and subsidies. The outcomes will feed into the Action Plan, to be finalised by the end of 2025 and presented at the International Roundtable in January 2026.
